

CAMP KIT LIST FOR 2nd THUNDERSLEY (ST.PETER'S) CUB SCOUT PACK ALL
ITEMS ON THIS LIST ARE ESSENTIAL

ITEM No. DESCRIPTION

1. Uniform (Must travel to and from camp in uniform)
2. Anorak/waterproof cagoule & waterproof trousers **MUST HAVE**
3. Outdoor footwear e.g. Wellington boots **MUST HAVE**
4. Trainers
5. spare trainers
6. Sleeping bag (preferably 3-4 season one).
7. Blanket and woolly hat in case of cold night
8. Small Pillow / Inflatable pillow
9. Groundsheet (6 x 4 or similar)
10. Karrimat (rubber mat placed under sleeping bag available from Camping & General)
11. Pyjamas
12. Change of clothes after arriving (casual gear) tee shirt / warm top / trousers etc
13. Spare clothes- underwear x 3 / socks x 3 / trousers & shorts x 3 / t-shirts x 3 and top
14. Handkerchiefs/tissues
15. Washing kit (soap, flannel, towel, toothbrush & toothpaste in toilet bag)
16. Tea towel (old)
17. (a) 1 plate (unbreakable, plastic or enamel) for dinner, cereal bowl for sweet
(b) Drinking mug (unbreakable, plastic or enamel)
(c) Knife, fork and spoon (metal not plastic)
Items a, b & c ARE TO BE PLACED IN A TIE-UP LINEN BAG
18. Torch (With spare long life batteries) do not put batteries in torch prior to arrival
19. Books or comics to read
20. Plastic carrier bags to keep clothes clean and dry & Black Sack x 2
21. Coat hanger
22. Sun hat
23. Max £3.00 pocket money to be handed to the bank on arrival
24. Sun cream / insect repellent are available in First Aid Kit - need to sign permission
25. Medication - written instructions for its use - all to be given to Leader on arrival

- . PLEASE HAVE EVERYTHING MARKED CLEARLY WITH CUBS NAME
- . DO NOT MARK PLATES, MUG, KNIFE, FORK & SPOON WITH STICKING PLASTER, AS THIS WILL COME OFF IN THE WASH. I WOULD SUGGEST ENAMEL PAINT OR NAIL VARNISH.
- . ALL OF THE ABOVE ITEMS TO BE PLACED IN ONE HOLDALL OR RUCKSACK.
- . NO JEANS - UNSUITABLE BECAUSE THEY HOLD WATER TOO MUCH
- . NO POCKET OR SHEATH KNIVES PLEASE
- . NO AEROSOL CANS PLEASE.
- . NO GAMEBOYS OR BATTERY TOYS
- . I regret that no responsibility can be accepted by the Camp organisers for personal equipment, clothing and effects. The Scout Association does not provide cover in respect of such items.

Please Note - Sometimes several boys arrive without certain critical items of clothing. If this should happen I will call you so that you can deliver the items to camp. Ensure you pack all the above items - trainers are NOT outdoor protective footwear. Your children may be getting wet. Also please label all items or you could lose them!
